The Piner-Olivet Charter School has over \$163,000 budgeted in supplemental grant expenditures for2016-2017, which exceeds the amount estimated as supplemental grant revenue if the LCFF were fully funded. The Piner-Olivet Charter School's unduplicated percentage is asof October, 2015 is 49.86%, the estimated unduplicated percentage for 2016-2017 is 49.07%. Both amounts exceed the 40% level and so are able to spend supplemental fundson schoolwide programs. The supplemental grant funds for 2016-2017 will fund Program Assistants to work with students needing extra help during, before and after school,Program Assistants to work with students in a leadership program, Outreach Workers to assist with translating for EL students and families, counseling for students includingany foster youth, and professional development for staff in California Content Standards, ELD and PBL.

Piner-Olivet Charter School offers over 5,000 instructional minutes to unduplicated students before and after school and during the summer which are over and above the base program for all students. This additional 5,000 instructional minutes equates to an added 8.5% of instructional time.
