




















































- 1.1 **Effective Instruction:** Recruit and retain highly qualified staff, ensure effective instruction and support, maintain competitive salaries, and monitor teacher assignments for appropriate placement.
- 1.2 **Instructional Support Services:** Provide instructional support personnel to address classroom needs, especially for disadvantaged students, and ensure access to college preparatory courses and A-G classes with ongoing teacher support to improve performance and graduation rates.
- 1.3 **Implementation of State Standards:** Provide all students with appropriate standards-aligned textbooks, instructional materials, and digital resources, and ensure enrollment in all required areas of study.
- 1.4 **Resources to Support Course Access:** Maintain instructional materials and resources to support classroom needs in all content areas, enhancing program quality, student engagement, and real-world learning opportunities.
- 1.5 **New Teacher Induction and Support:** The HBUHSD Induction Program provides individualized mentoring and professional learning for first and second-year teachers, guiding them to clear their preliminary credential and meet the needs of all students through innovative learning and differentiated instruction.
- 1.6 **Professional Development and Support for Certificated and Classified Staff:** Provide foundational professional development for certificated and classified staff, focusing on state academic standards, instructional practices, leadership, and collaboration, coordinated with federal Title II programs and the Educator Effectiveness Block Grant.
- 1.7 Information and Technology Services: Provide innovative and accessible technology services in computing, media, and telephone support to empower students, parents, faculty, and staff, ensuring effective collaboration and success within the HBUHSD community.
- 1.8 Instructional Technology Tools and Library/Media Resources to Enhance Teaching and Learning: Ensure equity and access to technology and learning supports for all students by providing digital devices, personalized instruction, Al policies, digital citizenship programs, and extended library/media services.
- 1.9 Data and Assessment: Provide evaluation services to collect data and complete reports for schools and the district, using metrics to measure progress, inform instruction, and identify students' needs, with a focus on supporting English learners, low-income students, and foster youth.
- 1.10 **Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS):** Coordinate MTSS lead teachers to align systems for student success, focusing on professional development, progress monitoring, evidence-based interventions, and social-emotional support for English learners, low-income students, and foster youth.















































- 2.1 **College Readiness:** Provide programs and services that support college readiness, including dual enrollment, college credit courses, and guidance services to address A-G completion gaps and support equity.
- 2.2 **Career Readiness:** Expand career readiness through sequenced pathways aligned to high-wage, in-demand careers, integrating work-based learning, CTSOs, and marketing initiatives to address equity and A-G completion gaps.
- 2.3 **Extended Learning Opportunities Interventions and Enrichment:** Provide extended learning opportunities, including study skills, remediation, tutoring, and credit recovery, with targeted support for credit-deficient and below-grade-level students to address performance gaps.
- 2.4 Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID): Continue offering the AVID program at all high schools to close opportunity gaps, focusing on teacher capacity, academic success skills, high expectations, tutorials, strong student-teacher relationships, college and career readiness, and supporting college visits and professional development.
- 2.5 **AP/IB Support:** Supplement funding for low-income students taking Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams.
- 2.6 **STEAM:** Implement STEAM initiatives to promote interest in STEAM careers, support participation in related activities, and acquire materials for Next Generation Science Standards.
- 2.7 **English Learner Supports:** Ensure English learners meet annual English language development objectives, with access to State Academic Standards and ELD standards, through designated and integrated support and professional development for teachers.






- 2.8 **Long Term English Learner Supports:** Reclassify English Learners as RFEP when they achieve necessary English skills, and support Long Term English Learners (LTEL) with school engagement, literacy development, academic support, and teacher training.
- 2.9 Homeless and Foster Youth Supports: Provide supplementary services for foster and homeless youth, maintain liaisons, collaborate with agencies, identify and support students by allocating funds for academic support, offer professional development, and update resource guides.
- 2.10 **Special Education Supports:** Increase collaboration between special education and general education teachers, implement MTSS monitoring, provide targeted support and intervention classes, promote state test participation, use interim assessments and math diagnostics, and review pathways for proper placement of students with disabilities.






MAINTAIN % OF FAVORABLE RESPONSES ON LOCAL CLIMATE SURVEY ON SCHOOL SAFETY





























- 3.6 **Well-Maintained School Facilities:** Ensure a safe learning environment with adequate operational resources and provide efficient transportation for eligible students.




































- 4.1 Student Support Systems: Enhance student progress monitoring and support through the Student Support Facilitator (data analysis, intervention development, credit recovery, student and parent engagement, resourcing classrooms), and providing teacher coaching and professional development.
- 4.2 **Progress Monitoring:** Implement a robust assessment and data collection system to measure student growth and inform instructional practices.
- 4.3 **Social-emotional Well-being:** Provide comprehensive support for wellness through full-time case managers from Project Hope Alliance and Stand Up For Kids, offering academic plans, mentoring, progress monitoring, external resources, parent involvement, college and career support, and 24/7 access.
- 4.4 **Expanded Day Opportunities:** Implement expanded learning opportunities with intervention programs, additional credit recovery options, and summer school.
- 4.5 **Supplemental Resources:** Enrich student experiences with supplemental curriculum resources, upgraded technology, necessary materials, and support for wellness, transportation, and mitigating barriers to success.
