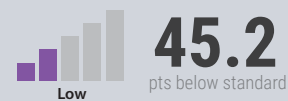


### Math Proficiency of Students with Disabilities

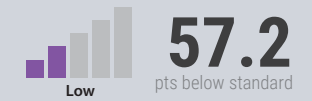
