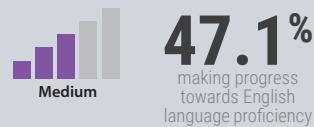
Graduation Rate

English Learner Progress

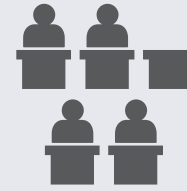

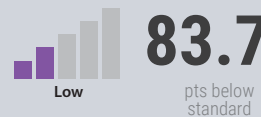
Chronic Absenteeism

Indicator: CA School Dashboard



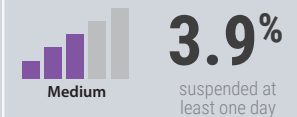
Mathematics
